Admission to the competition requires one of the following:

The following certificates, obtained no earlier than 4 calendar years before the end of the current competition registration, are required:

For the English language:

- TOEFL (90 iBT), IELTS (minimum average score of 6.5), or CAMBRIDGE (FCE) certificate;
- B2 level proficiency certificate CERTUS (<u>https://naec.ge/#/ge/post/1704</u>). The next round of testing is scheduled for 13 November. For further details, please visit the National Testing and Assessment Centre page.

For German language: TestDaF (TDN 3), DSH (DSH 1), DSD (B2), Goethe Certificate (90-100);

For Italian language: CILS (B2), PLIDA (B2);

b) Based on the results of institutional exam in foreign languages organized by the university (with a minimum score of 71), the result is valid for the semester in which the test was taken and for the following semester. Therefore, for the purposes of this competition, the test results from March 6, 2024, and/or October 4, 2024, are considered valid.

c) An official certificate confirming attendance at a foreign higher education institution for no less than one semester, indicating the language of instruction, must be provided. The language used in the program at that university should correspond to the language of instruction for which you are applying.

d) Studying in a foreign-language program at TSU where the language of instruction corresponds to the language used in the university/program you are applying for.

e) Students enrolled in fully foreign-language educational programs at TSU are exempt from the requirement of foreign language testing for the language of their program, except in cases where the host university requires proof of foreign language testing from specific scholarship recipients.

The selection process for scholarship recipients:

- Review of the electronic application and relevant documentation (Tbilisi State University)
- > Interview with the candidate selection committee (Tbilisi State University and/or the host university)
- > Final selection/granting of the scholarship (host university).
