

Associate Professor, PhD Rusudan Sanadze

Rusudan Sanadze is Associate Professor at Iv. Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University at Department of Education, Faculty of Psychology and Educational Sciences. Her main responsibilities and activities as an acting lecturer and scientist could be described but not limited as follows:

Starting from May 2016 she is a member of the Academic board of Iv. Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University. In 2017 she has successfully completed Trainer Accreditation workshop and is eligible to deliver EFQM trainings — J2E, L4E, and the internal assessor training. She is nominated as a PM of TSU in EFQM project way to excellence. Simultaneously, she was invited as an expert on education at the Ministry of Education and Sciences of Georgia in the framework of a planning/implementing monitoring scheme for the pre-school education sector.

Since 2003, she has conducted courses (Research Methods in Education; Adult Education ect.) at the Bachelor and the Master degree program at TSU, and since 2008, she has lead Courses at TSU Doctoral Program and mentored four PhD thesis's at TSU. She has supervised more than 40 MA theses at the TSU Educational programme: Management of Education. Currently she supervises 3 PhD students.

Sanadze's main research interest is the higher school problematic (Evaluation, QA, IT in Education etc.). As a doctoral researcher she has earned several scholarships (DAAD 2007-2008, TSU/DAAD 2006 (6/7), TSU/DAAD 2004(2/3)) and as a PhD in Educational sciences (2009) she was involved in several educational projects mainly at TSU. Rusudan's academic

credentials include a PhD in Education Sciences, an MA in Educational Sciences, a BA in Applied Mathematics and Computer Sciences. Besides, she has ten years of project management experience in the informational technologies field. As a top manager, she worked in strategic IT projects as a project manager and strategic planner.
