Who Can Participate?

- All Startup Facilitation Centers in Asia, Africa, Middle East, Australia and Europe government, university-based, private, sectoral or rural are eligible.
- You DO NOT need to be nominated by a school, college, or university.
- You may **register independently**, as a stand-alone incubator or with institutional collaboration.

Targeted Domains

Phase	Description
Registration	June–August 2025 — Online form + brief showcase proposal
Pitch Deck Submission	Highlight your unique model, and social/market impact through a pitch deck and pitch video
Promotion and Validation	Promote the pitch video in public domain to connect institutions and startups with aligned facilitation centers.
Internal Evaluation	See Section on Evaluation Criteria
Incubation Phase	25 domain specific teams will be assigned to each incubator to experience incubation support.
Grand Finale	December, Pune
Results & Rewards	Showcased at International Stage + eligible for potential grants & CSR tie-ups
Post-Event Integration	Incubation Center will be listed in the official Startup Nation Partner Incubator Directory and be given access to mentorship pools, investor networks, partners and premium startups

Dedicated Incubator Track – Format & Phases

Incubation Phase

Top 2% startups (250 startups) will be allocated to top 100 incubation centers in a batch of 25 startups each. Incubation centers will provide basic incubation support for a period of 6 weeks. This will allow startups to get an insight about the operations and support available with the incubation center. It is also an opportunity for incubation centers to identify key startups for longer incubation support. The support provided to startups will be evaluated by startups using a point based matrix to identify top 50 incubation centers for the next round.

Evaluation Criteria for Early-Stage Startup Incubation Centers

1. Vision & Strategic Alignment (10 Marks)

- Clarity of vision and mission.
- Alignment with national/regional startup or innovation goals.
- Focus on emerging sectors, deep tech, or societal challenges.

2. Infrastructure & Facilities (10 Marks)

- Availability of physical infrastructure (co-working space, labs, internet, etc.)
- Access to prototyping, testing, or specialized equipment.
- Digital infrastructure for remote incubation or virtual support.

3. Mentor & Expert Network (30 Marks)

- o Strength and diversity of mentor pool (industry, academia, investors).
- Active involvement of mentors in startup support.
- Access to domain experts, IP advisors, legal, and financial consultants.

4. Industry & Investor Linkages (20 Marks)

- Established partnerships with corporates, MSMEs, or industry bodies.
- Investor connections (angel networks, VCs).
- Access to market opportunities or pilot projects.

5. Sustainability & Business Model (30 Marks)

- Revenue generation plans (membership, equity, services).
- Financial sustainability beyond grants.
- Plans to scale operations and support more startups.
