The Embassy of Israel in Georgia is pleased to share information regarding the Scholarship Program of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Israel for the 2026/2027 academic year.

The scholarship program offers opportunities for:

- MA studies
- PhD studies
- Postdoctoral studies
- Research programs
- Hebrew Ulpan summer studies

Eligibility:

- Georgian citizens only (applicants with Israeli citizenship are not eligible)
- Applicants must hold at least a BA degree
- Age up to 35 at the beginning of studies
- High academic standing
- Good command of English (interview in English required)

Priority fields of study include:

- Social Sciences
- International Relations
- Political Science
- Jewish Studies
- History of Israel
- Literature
- Hebrew Language

Scholarship Coverage:

- Partial tuition support (up to 50% of tuition fees for two semesters, maximum USD 6,000)
- Monthly living allowance for academic programs
- Basic medical insurance

Required Documents:

- Academic transcripts and degree certificates
- Two recommendation letters
- Research proposal (where applicable)
- Proof of English proficiency
- Additional university-specific documents if required

Application Deadline:

All application materials must be submitted no later than 1 June 2026.
