## Korea Foundation (KF)

Since its founding in 1991, the Korea Foundation (KF) has served as Korea's foremost public diplomacy agency. It conducts and supports diverse exchange projects that promote a better understanding of Korea in the international community and increase friendship and goodwill between Korea and the rest of the world.

## KF Global e-School

The KF Global e-School, which was launched in 2011, has been especially active over the past decade in providing online courses by prominent Korean and foreign universities on Korean language/studies to universities all over the world. As of 2020, approximately 40,000 students at 215 universities in 56 countries have taken courses on Korea.

## **KF Global e-School SNU Program**

SNU academic year

Spring semester: March 1 – around June 20 (15 weeks)

Fall semester: September 1 – around December 20 (15 weeks)

SNU program provides Korea-related courses to overseas partner universities in social science and humanities areas including Korean language classes. All courses, undergraduate and graduate, emphasize comparative perspectives and are offered by leading professors of SNU.

Most of SNU regular courses are three-credit-hour courses (3 hour/week \* 15 weeks). Differences in academic calendars and credit units between SNU and partner universities are coordinated before the start of the class and successfully worked out so far.

As of March 2023, we have offered 142 courses to 22 universities in Japan, China, Thailand, Vietnam, Philippines, Russia, Australia, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Mongolia, and East Timor.
